'From Front Line to Home Front: British Medical Evacuations during the First World War'



Jessica Meyer is University Academic Fellow in Legacies of War at the University of Leeds where she leads the Medicine and War strand of the Legacies of War research and engagement hub. Her monograph *Men of War: Masculinity and the First World War in Britain* was published by Palgrave Macmillan in 2009. She is currently completing a monograph on the work and experiences of the non-commissioned servicemen of the Royal Army Medical Corps during the War for Oxford University Press. She also leads the European Research Council-funded Men, Women and Care project, exploring the histories of State, charitable and domestic care for British disabled ex-servicemen after the war.
